In spelling PLT sessions, pupils study the origin or a word, explore the definition, word class and synonyms. Pupils break works down to support understanding of sounds. Additional Fresh start sessions are also taking place during spelling PLT, which allow pupils to build knowledge of sounds, decode words and gain reading fluency.
