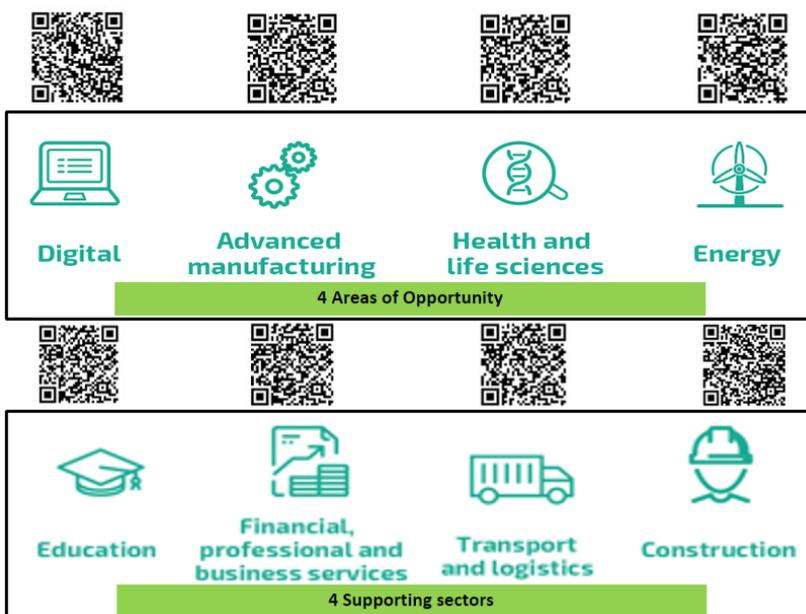


Labour Market Information

Labour Market Information (LMI) refers to the current state of the jobs market. This information can refer to the jobs market locally, regionally or nationally. This information is key to make informed decisions when job hunting, planning for career progression or researching pathways into employment. LMI can include:

- The industries that operate in a specific area, as well as the career opportunities within those industries.
- The sectors that are growing in a specific area, region or nationally, which can inform students of future job opportunities.
- The skills in high demand generally, or that are needed in a specific job role.
- Typical rates of pay and employee incentives on offer.
- Career progression opportunities.
